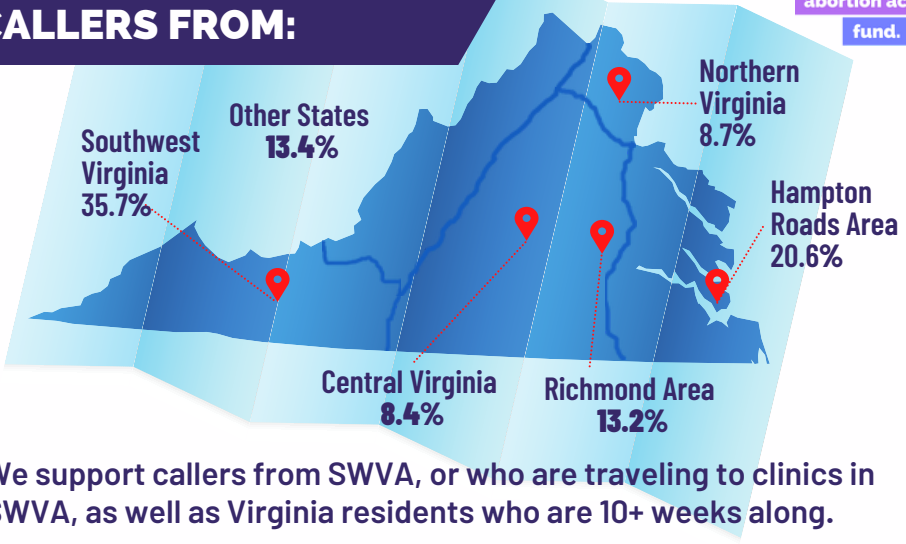

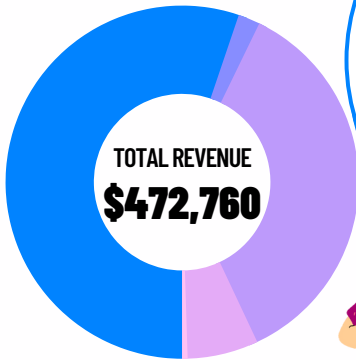

We support callers from SWVA, or who are traveling to clinics in SWVA, as well as Virginia residents who are 10+ weeks along.

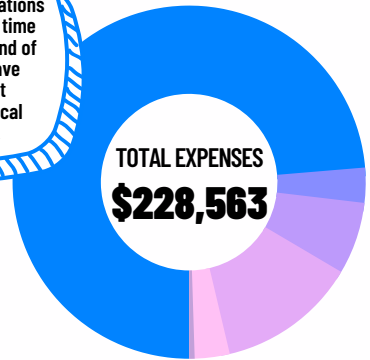

FY 2022 FINANCIALS:



- One-time individual donations (55.2%)
- Recurring individual donations (2%)
- Grants (35.8%)
- Other (6.5%)
- Corporate donations (0.5%)

Why the difference? We received significant donations in June and didn't have time to spend it before the end of the fiscal year. We have increased our direct assistance and practical support since then!



- Direct abortion assistance (73.6%)
- Practical support (3.2%)
- Management and admin (6.6%)
- Salary and payroll (12.8%)
- Fundraising (3.2%)
- Other (0.5%)
